Rozelle Markets

Most of the merchandise here is so cheap it's hard not to buy it even if you don't need it.

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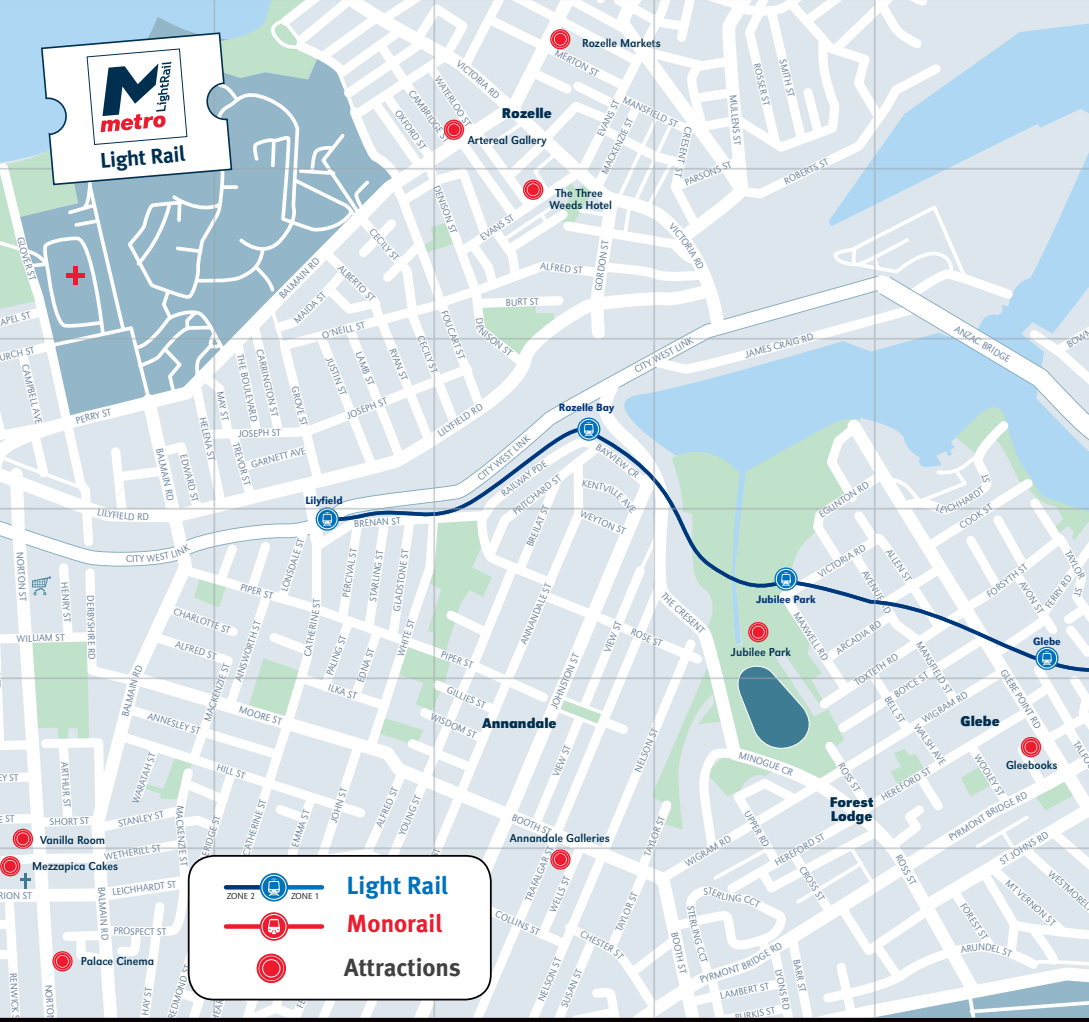

Carnivores are catered for with signature dishes such as miso-marinated baby chicken; and braised wagyu beef with ginger sauce. In Japanese Toko means 'room within a house to relax' and this chic yet informal style of eating is quintessentially Sydney.

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pasta night on Wednesdays. The Roxbury's various areas offer activities for every mood, whether it is watching the game or listening to local music acts. www.roxbury.com.au

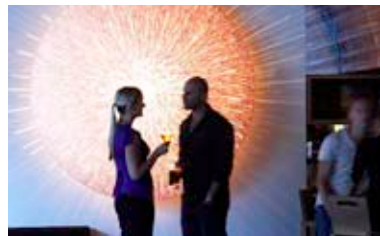
